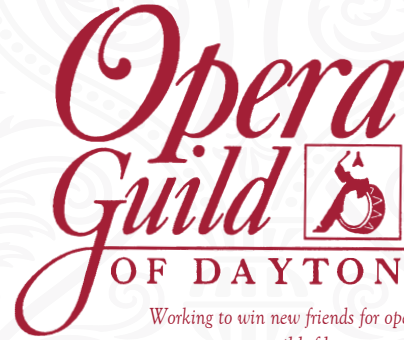

- A \$25 non-refundable application fee

Additional Information

- Up to six finalists will be selected by preliminary judges
- All entrants will be notified by email in late March
- Finalists will compete before a panel of judges on Sunday, April 5, 2020
